

Itinerary Summary

- **05:30 hrs:** Pick-up from your accommodation in **Puerto Natales** in private 4x4 vehicles, in small groups.
- Transfer north toward the **Province of Última Esperanza**.
- Stop in **Cerro Castillo** for restroom facilities.
- Entrance to **Torres del Paine National Park**.
- Visit to strategic areas such as **Lago Sarmiento** and **Laguna Amarga**.
- Easy walks through areas frequented by **pumas**.
- Observation of **native wildlife**: guanacos, foxes, condors, and birds of prey.
- Full-day experience dedicated to **puma tracking in its natural habitat**.
- Return to **Puerto Natales** in the afternoon.



Itinerary

- The excursion begins early, around **05:30 am**, with pick-up from your accommodation in **Puerto Natales**. From there, the journey heads north across the patagonian steppe and the **Cerro Castillo** area, where a stop is made for restroom facilities, before continuing into **Torres del Paine National Park**, where the landscape transforms and the Paine Mountain Range accompanies the route throughout.
- Inside the park, key areas such as **Lago Sarmiento** and **Laguna Amarga** are explored, combining vehicle travel with **easy walks** through areas frequented by **pumas**, where it is also possible to observe **native wildlife** such as guanacos, foxes, condors, and birds of prey.



Itinerary

- During the tour, guests **enjoy a snack**, perfect for recharging energy while continuing the search for pumas in their natural habitat. After a full day of exploration, the return to **Puerto Natales** takes place in the **afternoon**.
- While puma sightings cannot be guaranteed, the areas visited and the guides' expertise offer a **high probability of encounters**, making this experience one of the most authentic and exciting ways to connect with the **wild nature of Patagonia**.
